**Task:** Create a set of content cards, 13 total Units, that represent specific moments in time, key events, people, concepts, geographical locations, and theories that represent the core content of the history of the United States of America.

### Front of Content Card:

- term # (top right)
- term (center)
- date of term (center below term)
- initials (bottom right)

### Grading: Front of Content Cards

- minus one letter grade for not including any of the required **4** items (term #, term, date of historical significance for the term, and your initials)

### Back of Content Card

- 2 – 3 facts or historically significant concepts per term (1<sup>st</sup> edit)
- Date line: the date of completion of term
- 2 – 3 revised concepts, or historically significant concepts

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### Grading: Back of Content Cards

- lack of information on back of card = - 5 points per term (1 Cvrk)

- lack of date line for 10 + cards will result in the loss of a letter grade
- lack of additional research & historical significance for 10+ cards results in loss of 1 letter grade
