Guided Study Questions: Reading, Vocabulary, and Review

The American Revolution

Students will utilize the US History Review Videos, The <u>ABC US History Review Book</u>, <u>A Nation Conceived in Liberty</u> review book, and their class notes Standards #3a- #3c (The causes of the American Revolution) to answer the Guided Study Ouestions (GSOs).

- c. Analyze George Washington as a military leader, including but not limited to the influence of Baron von Steuben, the Marquis de LaFayette, and the significance of Valley Forge in the creation of a professional military.

- e. Examine the roles of women, American Indians, and enslaved and free Blacks in supporting the war effort.
- f. Explain the significance of the Treaty of Paris, 1783.

- 5. What were the weaknesses of the Americans and the Continental Army heading into the Revolutionary War?
- 6. How did the French contribute to the American Revolution? Who was key in securing their alliance?

- 8. What was the significance of the Continental Army's winter at Valley Forge?
