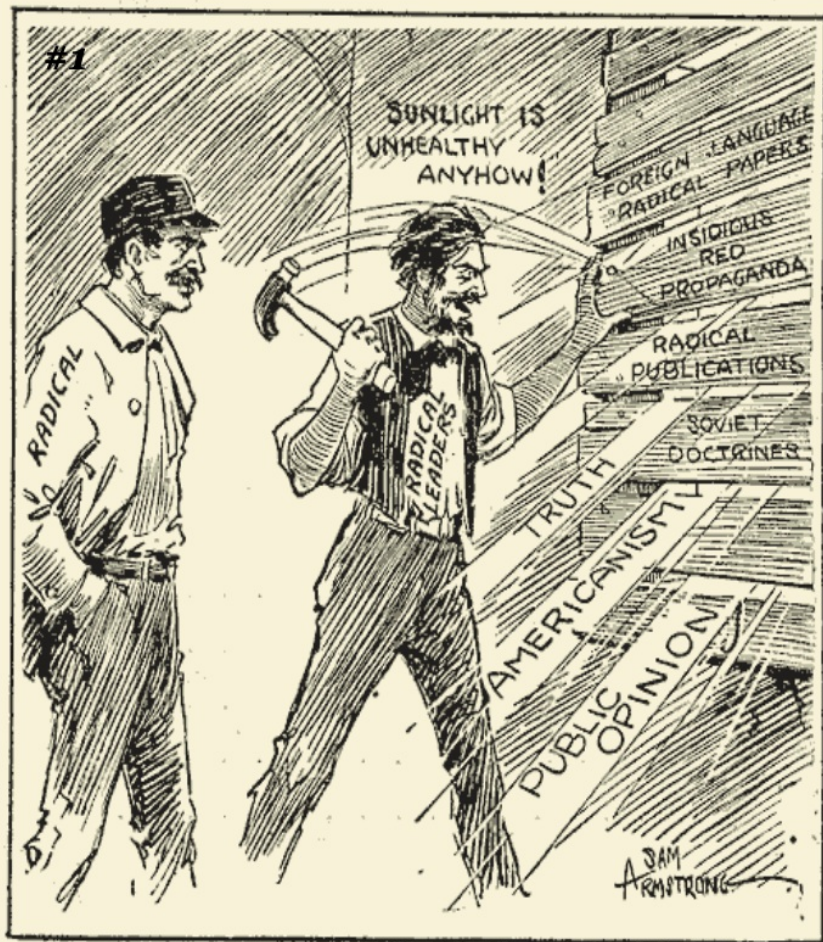


Journal #38b: The Red Scare, the American Press, and Sacco and Vanzetti

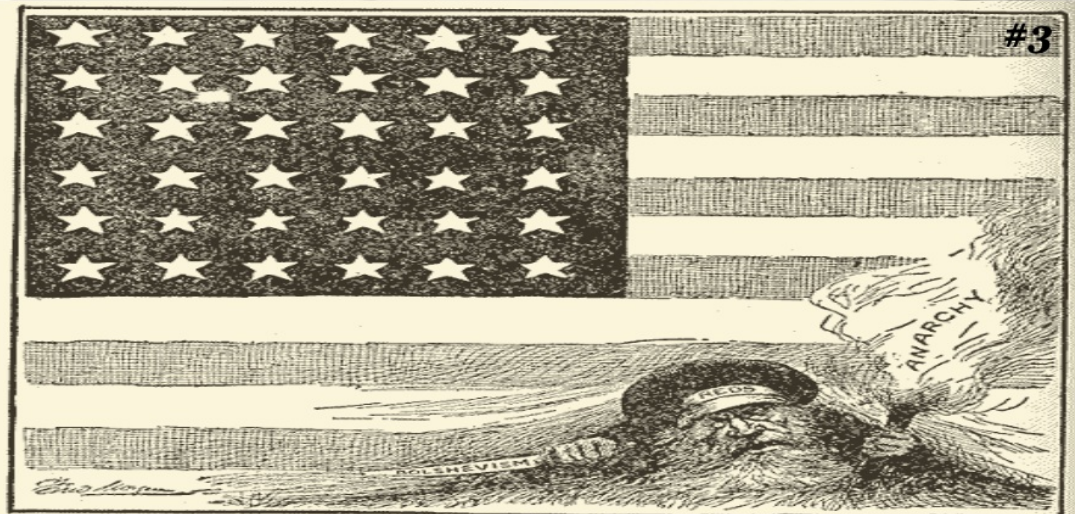
Item Analysis: Identify all of the Items/Objects within the Cartoons and the photograph
